Notice of application for a licence to impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, Wessex Region by Mr. Nadim Dayeh, of Hale Close House, Hale, Hampshire, for a licence to impede the flow of the existing watercourse situated at Hale Close House, in the Parish of Hale, District of New Forest, County of Hampshire at NGR SU 188183. The object of impounding water by means of the works is the creation of a series of, one off stream, and two on stream lakes together with a by pass overflow ditch. The total capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 2400 cubic metres. Further details of the application include the provision of control works to ensure that under low flow conditions, flows below the site can be maintained at levels equal to the natural inflow. Filling will be restricted to times of high winter flows or occasional summer thunderstorms.
