TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Proposed stopping-up of an area of unnamed highway between Taylor Square and Drake Road, Tavistock

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A17 Trunk Road (Wigtoft—Sutterton Bypass) and the A16 Trunk Road (Diversion at Blackitt's Farm) Order 1990

The A16 Trunk Road (Blackitt's Farm to Sutterton) Detrunking Order 1990

The A17 Trunk Road (Wigtoft—Sutterton Bypass) and the A16 Trunk Road (Diversion at Blackitt's Farm) (Side Roads) Order 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

1. an Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that a road about 4.16 kilometres in length, which he proposes to construct from west of Wigtoft to east of Sutterton, and a road about 180 metres in length which he proposes to construct as a link between the first proposed new road and the A16 trunk road, in the county of Lincolnshire shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into force;
2. an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that the length of the A17 trunk road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Lincolnshire (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the roads mentioned at 1 above are open for the through traffic;
3. an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that the length of the A16 trunk road to be superseded shall (if that length is then still a trunk road) cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Lincolnshire (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the roads mentioned at 1 above are open for through traffic; and
4. an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
 - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
 - (b) to stop-up highways,
 - (c) to construct new highways,
 - (d) to stop-up private means of access to premises, and
 - (e) to provide new means of access to premises,

and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Lincolnshire as from the date on which he notifies that Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
