

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highway Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirements of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks from 27th December 1990, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provisions contained therein.

The A435 Trunk Road (Improvement at Junction with Back Lane (Little Beckford) (Side Roads) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that the proposal to make the above-mentioned Order, which was advertised on 11th May 1989, has been abandoned.

The proposed Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 was to stop-up a length of Back Lane (eastern leg) and to improve Back Lane (western leg).

Alternative measures involving signing and roadmarkings will be undertaken to improve safety at this junction.
