Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Bolton hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and all other enabling powers for authorising the Council:

- (a) to carry out improvements to Wigan Road, Market Street, Park Road, Bolton Road, Mill Street, an un-named highway leading to Clough Fold, an un-named highway leading to Wade Bank, Leigh Road George Street, Rosebery Street, Back Rosebery Street, Mill Square;
- (b) to stop up lengths of the un-named highway giving access to Nos. 39-53 The Welland, Mill Street, Back Leigh Road, Back Rosebery Street, Leigh Road, an un-named highway leading to Wade Bank, Mill Square;

(c) to construct new highways between Rosebery Street and Back Rosebery Street, between Mill Street and the Classified Road and between Southfield Drive and the Classified Road (footpath);

(d) to stop-up private means of access to Westhoughton Cricket Club cricket ground, vacant land to the south of 14 Mill Street, 78 Park Road, commercial premises situated between Mill

Street and Mill Square.

(e) to provide new means of access to the said premises.

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified roads which the Council is proposing to construct between Wigan Road and Park Road, Westhoughton.
