TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Proposed Stopping-up of Highways at Walkden, Salford

Notice is hereby given that a local Inquiry is to be held in connection with the proposal of the Secretary of State for Transport to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act authorising the stopping-up of lengths of Granville Street and Campbell Way, Walkden, Salford.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A660 Leeds-Otley Trunk Road (Kings Road Junction Improvement Side Roads) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Golden Acre Corner at Bramhope in the Metropolitan District of Leeds to make under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order which will:

- (a) authorise him;
 - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter The Sycamores and Kings Road,
 - (ii) to stop up a length of The Sycamores and Kings Road,
 - (iii) to construct a new highway to connect The Sycamores with the Trunk Road,
 - (iv) to stop up a private means of access to premises, and
 - (v) to provide new means of access to premises, all at Golden Acre Corner, Bramhope aforesaid; and
- (b) provide for the transfer of that new highway to the Metropolitan District Council of Leeds as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
