STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS AT RAVENSCROFT TOWER HILL, KIRKBY

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Metropolitan Borough of Kirkby) (No. 2) Order 1991" authorising the stopping up of various footpaths and part of a highway all at Blocks E, F, G and H, Ravenscroft Tower Hill, Kirkby, and requiring the provision of new highways.
