

## PIPE-LINES ACT 1962

*Proposed Stanlow to Tranmere Fuels Oils Pipeline*

Shell U.K. Limited hereby give notice, in accordance with the provisions of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Pipe-lines Act 1962 and Regulation 7(3) of the Electricity and Pipe-line Works (Assessment of Environmental Effects) Regulations 1990, that an application has been made to the Secretary of State for Energy for the grant of authorisation, for construction of a cross-country pipeline.

The proposed pipeline, which is to be for the conveyance of fuel oils, is to run between a tie-in point on the Tranmere/Eastham pipe-line at Eastham and Stanlow Island.

The pipeline will be owned by Shell U.K. Limited.
