## SUNDERLAND BOROUGH COUNCIL

BOROUGH OF SUNDERLAND CLEAN AIR ACTS 1956 AND 1968  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980*Proposed Smoke Control Area No. 28*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Sunderland in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended, propose to make an Order, entitled The Sunderland (No. 28) Smoke Control Order 1991, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £200 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will come into operation before 1st July 1991 or before a later date determined by the Council.
