NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

The New Town of Milton Keynes Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way over parts of Footpath No's 10 and 12 Shenley Brook End, Tattenhoe Employment.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the rights of way over the following routes shown coloured red on the map referred herein:

That lengths of footpath No. 12 in the Parish of Shenley Brook End from a point marked "A" on the map approximately 60 metres east of the Standing Way, Buckingham Road roundabout and running in a northerly and north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 610 metres to a point marked "B" on the map approximately 150 metres south of Tattenhoe Hall Farm.

That length of footpath No. 10 in the parish of Shenley Brook End from a point marked "C" on the map approximately 300 metres north-east of the Standing Way, Buckingham Road roundabout and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 570 metres to a point marked "D" being the paths junction with the city leisure route to the north of Loughton Brook, approximately 150 metres north-east of Water Spinney.
