Gwent County Council (Lodge Road (near Westgate Court) (Caerleon)) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to revoke the Newport Borough Council (Lodge Road and Various Roads) (Parts) (Caerleon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.

To prohibit waiting at any time on those lengths of road as set out in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) Loading or unloading goods;
- (c) The maintenance of the roads;
- (d) The supply of gas, water or electricity;
- (e) For emergency purposes, and
- (f) Local Authority duties.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted area and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Civic Centre, Newport and the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday).

If you wish to object to the proposals you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 21st June 1991.

SCHEDULE

*Prohibition of waiting at any time**Lodge Road*

- (a) North-east side from its junction with B4236 Goldcroft Common to a point 87 metres north-west of its junction with Westgate Court.
- (b) South-west side from its junction with B4236 Goldcroft Common to a point 88 metres north-west of its junction with Westgate Court.

High Street, west side from the south-western kerb-line of Lodge Road for a distance of 18 metres in a southerly direction.

Goldcroft Common B4236, north-west side from the north-eastern kerb-line of Lodge Road for a distance of 12 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Goldcroft Common

- (a) South-east side from its junction with Lodge Road for a distance of 5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- (b) North-west side from its junction with Lodge Road for a distance of 4 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Cold Bath Road

- (a) North-west side from its junction with Lodge Road to its south-western end.
- (b) South side from a point 47 metres south-west of the line of the south-western kerb of Lodge Road to its junction with Lodge Road.

Broadwalk

- (a) South-east side from its junction with Lodge Road for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- (b) North-west side from its junction with Lodge Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Westgate Court

- (a) North-west side for a distance of 19 metres from its junction with Lodge Road.
- (b) South-east side for a distance of 22 metres from its junction with Lodge Road.

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to revoke Gwent County Council (Llanyrafon Way and Side Roads, Cwmbran

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983 and the County Council of Gwent (Llanyrafon Way, Cwmbran) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Revocation) Order 1986.

To prohibit waiting at any time on those lengths of road as set out in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers
- (b) Loading or unloading goods
- (c) the maintenance of the roads
- (d) The supply of gas, water or electricity
- (e) For emergency purposes
- (f) Local Authority duties

SCHEDULE

*Prohibition of Waiting at any time**Llanyrafon Way:*

- (a) North-west side from its junction with Llanfdechfa Way to a point 40 metres north-east of its south-western junction with Caernarvon Crescent.
- (b) North-west side from a point 101 metres north-east of its south-western junction with Caernarvon Crescent to a point 52 metres north-east of its junction with Kidwelly Road.
- (c) North-west side from a point 70 metres north-east of its junction with Kidwelly Road to its junction with Turnpike Road.
- (d) South-east side from its junction with Llanfdechfa Way to a point 12 metres north-east of its south-western junction with Liswerry Drive.
- (e) South-east side from a point 48 metres north-east of its south-western junction with Liswerry Drive to its junction with Turnpike Road.

Caernarvon Crescent:

- (a) Both sides from its north-eastern junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 15 metres.
- (b) South-west side from its south-western junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 14 metres.
- (c) North-east side from its south-western junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 18 metres.

Liswerry Drive:

- (a) South-west side from its south-western junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 15 metres.
- (b) South-west side from its north-eastern junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 60 metres.
- (c) North-east side from its north-eastern junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 72 metres.
- (d) North-east side from its south-western junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 10 metres.

Kidwelly Road:

- (a) South-west side from its junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 15 metres.
- (b) North-east side from its junction with Llanyrafon Way for a distance of 10 metres.

Llanfdechfa Way:

- (a) North-east and east side from a point 25 metres north-west of its junction with Llanyrafon Way to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Llangorse Road.

Llangorse Road:

- (a) North side from its junction with Llanfdechfa Way for a distance of 31 metres.
- (b) South side from its junction with Llanfdechfa Way for a distance of 12 metres.
