TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Town and Country Planning General Regulations 1976

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of Derbyshire) (No. 3) Order 1991". The Order comes into operation on 1st July 1991 and extinguishes any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on part of the West Side of Derby Market Place, Derby.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, by applying to the Director of Network Management and Construction, East Midlands Region Department of Transport, Room 805, Cranbrook House, Cranbrook Street, Nottingham NG1 1EY (quoting ref No. EMCM 5050/41/17/12) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the City Secretary's Office, Derby City Council, The Council House, Derby.

If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, within 6 weeks from 1st July 1991, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained in it.

Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application, any person who on 1st July 1991 has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the Derby City Council in respect of any depreciation in the value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. Any claim must be served on the Council at its above address within a period of 6 months from 1st
