If delivery of Treasury Bills into the Central Moneymarkets Office has been requested, payments will be effected through that system; otherwise payment in full of the amount due in respect of an accepted Tender must be made to the Bank of England, not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relevant Bills are to be dated and on which they are to be collected from the Securities Office, by one of following means:

- (a) cash
- (b) banker's draft payable through the Town Clearing,
- (c) cheque drawn on the Bank of England,
- (d) CHAPS payment (subject to evidence of payment) (Bills will only be released by the Bank of England when evidence of payment has been received.)

7. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Securities Office, Bank of England. Particular forms are available for Bills of each maturity.

8. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right to reject any Tenders.
