PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT 1931

The following amending Regulations made by the Architects Registration Council of the United Kingdom under section 13 of the above-mentioned Act have been submitted for the approval of the Privy Council:

Amending Regulation 1991

In respect of the Regulations made in pursuance of section 13 of the aforementioned Act the following shall be substituted for Regulation 37(1)(a) and (b):

“(a) £35 on an application made pursuant to section 6(1)(c) or section 6A of the Principal Act or to Regulation 26 (i), (ii), (iv), or (v).

(b) £150 on any other application”.
