#### WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The County of Wiltshire (Metrication of Weight Limits) Order 1991*

Notice is hereby given that on 30th July 1991, the Wiltshire County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing weight restriction Orders listed in the said Order by substituting the imperial weight measurements with the following metric weights:

- (i) Weight Restriction Orders with reference to the imperial measurement of "3 tons", unladen weight, shall be amended by the substitution of the metric equivalent "7.5 tonnes" maximum gross weight.
- (ii) Weight Restriction Orders with reference to the imperial measurement of "3 tons", whether laden or unladen, shall be amended by the substitution of the words "3 tonnes" whether laden or unladen.
- (iii) Weight Restriction Orders with reference to the imperial measurement of "2 tons", whether laden or unladen, shall be amended by the substitution of the words "2 tonnes", whether laden or unladen.

A copy of the Order and Plan may be inspected at the Chief Executive's Department (Legal Division), County Hall, Trowbridge during normal office hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the above Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of that section or of Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act or any regulation made under the said Schedule has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The Order will be operative as from 2nd September 1991.
