## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Cleveland) (No. 1) Order 1991" authorising the stopping-up of a length of Bracknell Road, Thornaby to enable development consisting of the erection of 14 dwellings and garages to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Lochrie Builders by Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 21st August 1991 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
