## SWANAGE RAILWAY COMPANY LIMITED

*The Swanage Light Railway (Extension) Order*

Notice is hereby given that the Swanage Railway Company Limited intends to apply to the Secretary of State for Transport, for the Swanage Light Railway (Extension) Order.

The line of the Railway will be from Harman's Cross, along the route of the former British Rail Branch, to Furzebrook, all in the District of Purbeck, in the County of Dorset.

The nominal gauge of the Railway will be 1,435 millimetres, and the motive power will be steam, electricity, internal combustion, or such other motive power as the Secretary of State may approve.

A Plan of the proposed works, and Book of Reference to the Plan, together with an Estimate of Costs, will be deposited on 22nd August 1991, at the offices of the Company at the Station, Swanage, Dorset, and will be available for inspection between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. On or after 22nd August 1991, copies of the draft Order can be obtained from the Company Secretary on payment of £1 per copy.

Copies of the draft Order, Plan, Section, Book of Reference, and Estimate of Costs, have been deposited with the Chief Executive of Dorset County Council, the Chief Executive of Purbeck District Council, the Town Clerks of Swanage Town Council and Wareham Town Council, and the Clerks of Langton Matravers, Worth Matravers and Corfe Castle Parish Councils, in which places the documents may be inspected on or after the date given above, during normal office hours.
