The Hertsmere Borough Council (Blanche Lane, South Mimms)
(Restriction of Driving) Order 1991

HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Holderness Borough) (Various Streets, Burstwick) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given, that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be:

(a) to prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time in parts of the following roads as specified below:

(i) *Back Lane/Station Road*, both sides, from the western kerb-line of Main Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.

(ii) *Main Street*:

Both sides:

from a point 15 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Station Road to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Station Road.

from a point 15 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Newbridge Road to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Newbridge Road.

West side, from a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Station Road to a point 15 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Newbridge Road.

(b) to limit waiting to 1 hour return prohibited within 1 hour, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday in part of the following road as specified below:

Main Street, east side, from a point 15 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Newbridge Road to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Station Road.

Exemptions will include permission to wait for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers at bus turning points, loading and unloading, the maintenance of roads, gas, water and electricity supplies and for police, ambulance and fire brigade purposes.
