The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that a joint local inquiry is to be held into:

- (a) A draft Order, proposed to be made by the Secretary of State for Transport under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. If made, the Order would authorise the stopping-up of Newhall Street and Fordrift (also known as the Fordrift), Sutton Coldfield, in the City of Birmingham, enabling development consisting of construction of a new shopping centre and associated car parking to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the said Act.

- (b) Two Orders submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation as made by the City of Birmingham under section 226(1)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, authorising them to acquire compulsorily for the purpose of development, redevelopment and improvement thereof, by the erection of a comprehensive development principally comprising shops, speciality kiosks, a mall cafe, market hall and ancillary car parking facilities of the land which forms part of Sutton Coldfield Town Centre. The schedule of plots affected can be inspected at the offices of the Council at the Central Executive Department, Directorate of Law and Regulation, Paradise Place, Birmingham, in normal office hours.

The joint inquiry will be held at the Josiah Mason Lecture Theatre, Paradise Complex, Birmingham, on Tuesday, 1st October 1991, at 10 a.m. by Dr. D. L. J. Robins, a person appointed by the Secretaries of State for those purposes.

This notice is given by the Secretary of State for Transport under section 252 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The Secretary of State for the Environment is causing notice to be given separately under other provisions of the above Acts.
