*Proposed West Burton Power Station
Ash Disposal Facility at Bole Ings*

Notice is hereby given that National Power Plc (whose registered office is at Sudbury House, 15 Newgate Street, London EC1A 7AU) has applied to the Secretary of State for Energy for consent for the extension of West Burton Power Station in Nottinghamshire to accommodate a new ash disposal scheme, and for the Secretary of State's direction that planning permission for the above-mentioned development shall be deemed to be granted.

A copy of the application, together with a plan showing the land to which it relates and a copy of the Environmental Statement setting out the Company's proposals in more detail and presenting an analysis of the environmental implications, with a summary thereof, are available for inspection during normal office hours at:
