#### HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (Monkland Road Housing Estate) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes) Order 1991.*

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in those roads in the Town and District of Leominster in the county of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Schedule to this notice which comprise the Monkland Road Housing Estate.

Exemptions are contained in the Order for vehicles of the following classes or for the following purposes if the vehicle:

- (b) is being used in any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus;
- (c) is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (d) is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from that vehicle;
- (e) is being used to gain access to any land or premises where there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
- (f) is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
- (g) is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (College Road Railway Bridge, Hereford) (Weight Restriction) Order 1991*

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be that no vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 17 tonnes shall use so much of College Road in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester from its junction with Burcot Road to its junction with Barrs Court Road as is carried by the College Road Railway Bridge.
