

WIGAN METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

Wigan Borough (Off Street Car Parks) (Civic Centre, 50 Millgate, Station Road East and West Sides and Mona Street East Side) (Wigan) (Charges) Order 1991.

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Off Street Car Parks) (Civic Centre, 50 Millgate, Station Road East and West Sides and Mona Street East Side) (Wigan) (Charges) Order 1991.

The pay and display car parks to which the Order will point to are:

- (a) the car park at the rear of the Civic Centre, Wigan;
- (b) the car park adjacent to the Housing Department offices at 50 Millgate, Wigan;
- (c) the area of land adjacent to the easterly end of Stairgate, Wigan;
- (d) the area of land on the easterly side of Station Road opposite the easterly end of Stairgate;
- (e) the area of land adjacent to the easterly side of Mona Street, Wigan.

These car parks are used from Monday to Friday by Council staff. They are available on Saturdays and Sundays for public use. At present, no charge is made for use at weekends by members of the public. A consequence of this is that they are extensively used on Saturdays with the result that the Council suffers a loss of revenue to the extent that car parks at which a charge is made are not used.

The Council seeks to curtail that revenue loss by introducing a charge, on a pay and display basis, for the use of these car parks on Saturdays.

The proposed charge is as follows—

<i>Charges</i>	<i>£</i>
Not exceeding 1 hour	50p
Over 1 hour and not exceeding 3 hours	70p
Over 3 hours	£1.50

The charging hours will extend from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The car parks are available for use by motor vehicles which are constructed or adapted for the carriage of not more than seven persons (excluding the driver) or of goods, and which have a weight not exceeding 1525 kilograms. They may also be used by motor cycles and invalid carriages. A vehicle may not remain in any car park for more than 24 hours.

A copy of the proposed Order, and of a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Borough Solicitor, New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, not later than 30th September 1991.

New traffic proposals for the county of South Glamorgan

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends imposing traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule below.

The nature of the restriction is shown in Column 2 of the Schedule and the titles of the proposed orders are shown in Column 3.

Exemptions to the restrictions marked with an asterisk (*) will be permitted for boarding and alighting from a vehicle; loading and unloading of goods, essential services and funerals, for a maximum of two hours, vehicles when displaying an "orange badge" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.

Full details of the proposals and plans showing the location and extent of the proposed restrictions may be seen at the address shown below during normal office hours, or at Penarth Branch Library for that Order affecting the Penarth Area.

Any objection you may have to any of the proposals must be submitted to me in writing by 27th September 1991 and must contain the grounds on which you object. Any such objection may be made available for inspection by any interested parties in accordance with the Local Government Access to Information Act 1986.
