SCHEDULE

Position in which vehicle may wait: Wholly within a parking bay.

Classes of vehicle: All motor vehicles (not having a trailer attached) with a gross laden weight of 3.5 tonnes or less excluding the parking of coaches at Castlefield.

Days and hours of operation: At all times.

Maximum period: No limit.

Penalty charge: £10 if paid within 7 days of offence otherwise £20.

Penalty to be levied for: (a) Failing to display a valid ticket, or (b) leaving a vehicle for longer than the initial time paid for as displayed on the tickets, or (c) failing to park in a marked bay, (d) parking in a bay marked for the use of disabled person's vehicles, a vehicle not described as such in the Order, or (e) parking in a bay reserved for contract permit holders.

SEDGEMOOR DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Sedgemoor District Council (Prohibition of Right-hand Turns) (Eastover into Church Street, Bridgwater) (Revocation) Order 1991.

Notice is hereby given that on 4th September 1991, the Sedgemoor District Council, as agents for the Somerset County Council, made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), (2)(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to revoke the right-hand turn ban from Eastover into Church Street, Bridgwater.

The Order will come into operation on 16th September 1991. A copy of the Order may be inspected at Bridgwater House, King Square, Bridgwater, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act, or any Instrument made under it, had not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
