NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SOUTHERN REGION

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, Southern Region by the Roundstone Garden Centre Limited to vary the licence (serial No. 10/41/310106) to abstract water from a borehole into the chalk aquifer at south-west end of the Roundstone Garden Centre in the Parish of Rustington and in the district of Angmering (O.S. Grid ref. TQ 07580322). The variation applied for is to increase the abstraction rates as follows: Annually from 9,100 cubic metres to 18,200 cubic metres daily from 91 cubic metres to 191 cubic metres hourly from 13.65 cubic metres to 18 cubic metres; to change the purpose from horticulture excluding spray irrigation to horticulture including spray irrigation.
