(d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20

minutes), etc.

Nothing in the Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
