## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 248 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping up of two sections of the unnamed access road at the Westway Industrial Park, Throckley, in the interests of safety of users of, and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the new Westway Industrial Park Access Road, which is proposed to be constructed in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of that Act, by the Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council.

COMBINED MILITARY AND CIVIL AIR ACCIDENT  
INSPECTOR'S INVESTIGATION
