

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The East Sussex (Bannings Vale and Hamsey Road A259 Saltdean) (Experimental Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council have made an Order on 25th September 1991, under sections 9 and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, for an experimental period not exceeding 18 months, which prohibits any vehicle from turning right from Bannings Vale into A259 Coast Road Saltdean; from Hamsey Road into A259 Coast Road Saltdean; from A259 Coast Road Saltdean into Bannings Vale; from A259 Coast Road Saltdean into Hamsey Road.

The Order comes into operation on 7th October 1991.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the county council's reasons for making the Order may be examined at my office between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday to Friday inclusive and at Saltdean Post Office, 26 Langridge Avenue, Saltdean.

East Sussex County Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions should be continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any person wishing to object to this Order being continued in force indefinitely should send such an objection in writing, together with the grounds on which it is made, to me at the address below by 7th April 1992 (or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified by an Order made under section 9 or 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, not later than 6 months from the date of the coming into operation of such variation or modification).

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 25th September 1991, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The East Sussex (Military Road, Rye (Part) Weight Restriction) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2, 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will introduce a weight restriction on heavy commercial vehicles from using those lengths of the C296 Military Road, Rye, from its junction with the A268 at Rye Hill north-eastwards to a point 10 metres south of the border between the counties of East Sussex and Kent (known as Kent ditch).

Exemptions are included in the draft Order for heavy commercial vehicles used for emergency services purposes; loading/unloading goods; agricultural uses; building work, roadworks or maintenance of essential services; local or water authority purposes; for access to garage or repair shop; for removing obstructions to traffic.

A copy of the draft Order and plan showing the length of road affected together with a statement of the county council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and at the Post Office, Cinque Ports Street, Rye, until 25th October 1991.

Any objection to the proposal, together with the grounds on which it is made, should be sent to me in writing not later than 25th October 1991.

The County Council of West Sussex (Angmering: Roundstone By-pass (A259) and Station Road (A208) (Prohibition of Driving and Cycling) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit cycling over half the width of the newly-constructed cycleway/footpath which runs:

- (i) along the eastern side of Station Road, from the access road to Angmering School, southwards for 356 metres, and
- (ii) along the southern side of Roundstone By-pass, from opposite the traffic island in Station Road, eastwards for approximately 115 metres, including a side connection to Heathfield Avenue.

Driving of motor vehicles will also be prohibited on the lengths of cycleway/footpath.

The County Council of West Sussex (Slaugham-Handcross: High Street (A279) and Windmill Platt) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991
