The variations applied for are:

1. To vary licence number 9/40/3/428/G relating to Goudhurst Pumping Station to permit abstraction at rates up to 1.6 Mld (0.35 mgd) from a new borehole penetrating the Ashdown Beds at Finchcocks, Goudhurst (Grid reference TQ698364). The existing total annual and daily authorised quantities of 3,318.58 Mla (730 mga) and 9.09 Mld (2.0 mgd) in aggregate with licence No. 9/40/3/358/GR will remain unaltered.
2. To vary licence number 9/40/2/250/G relating to Boxley, Cossington and Forstal Pumping Stations to permit abstraction at rates up to 3.5 Mld (0.77 mgd) from a new borehole penetrating the Lower Greensand Strata at Boarley Reservoir, Boxley (Grid reference TQ761591). The aggregated daily quantity in combination with the existing borehole at Boxley will not exceed 3.5 Mld (0.77 mgd) and the existing total annual authorised quantity for the group licence will remain unaltered.

BASSETLAW DISTRICT COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Bassetlaw District Council (Bircotes) Area 17 Smoke Control Order 1991

Notice is hereby given, that the Bassetlaw District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, propose to make an Order entitled the Bassetlaw District Council (Bircotes) Area 17 Smoke Control Order 1991, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke

control area is proposed that the said Order will come into operation on 1st July 1992.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of subsection (4) of section 11 of the Act the general effect of the Order will be that if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £400) unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. By virtue of section 9 of the Clean Air Act 1968 it will, in addition, be an offence for any person to acquire any solid fuel, other than authorised fuel, for use in a building in a smoke control area (unless exempted pursuant to section 11 of the 1956 Act), for any person to sell such fuel by retail for delivery to a building in such an area. The offences are punishable by a fine not exceeding level 3 of the standard scale (currently £400).

Copies of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the council's offices at Queen's Buildings, Potter Street, Worksop, Nottingham and at Retford Information Centre, The Square, Retford, Nottingham at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from 1st November 1991.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Chief Executive, Bassetlaw District Council, Queen's Buildings, Potter Street, Worksop, Nottingham object to the making of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The southern boundary commences on Scrooby Road at its junction with Colliery Road and runs in an easterly direction until reaching the A614. The boundary proceeds north-easterly along the A613 until reaching the edge of Fish Pond Wood. The boundary then proceeds in a westerly direction before turning northwards along the West Wood estate until reaching the A631.

The northern boundary runs in a westerly direction along the A631 until reaching its junction with Bawtry Road. The boundary then runs south-easterly until reaching Snipe Park Wood. The boundary edges Snipe Park Wood in a south-westerly direction and then runs from Snipe Park Road to Scrooby Road in a southerly direction.
