Basildon District Council, Traffic Regulation Order

The District of Basildon (Hemmells, Laindon) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Basildon, pursuant to arrangements made with the Essex County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, and in exercise of the powers of the County Council under sections (1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer

of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act have been made on 1st November 1991, an Order the effect of which is:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at any time on the northern side of Hemmells, from the High Road to the junction with Newlands End and the southern side at the junction with the High Road; and
- (b) to restrict waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the southern side of Hemmells from the High Road to the Newlands End junction and including the junctions with Newlands End and Archer Road, Basildon.

A copy of the Order, which came into operation on 8th November 1991, together with the plan relating to it and a statement of reasons for making it may be examined at the under-mentioned office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 1st November 1991, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

This Order will come into operation on 8th November 1991.

BASILDON DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Basildon (Fodderwick/Southernhay, Basildon) (Revocation of Right Turns) and (Bluehouses, Southernhay, Basildon) (Prohibition of Right Turns and U-turns) Order 1991.

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Basildon, pursuant to arrangements made with the Essex County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, and in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Essex Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, intend to make a Traffic Order the effect of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit a right hand turn movement for vehicles from Bluehouses into the eastbound carriageway of Southernhay;
- (ii) to prohibit a "U" turn movement for vehicles from the westbound carriageway of Southernhay to the eastbound carriageway of that road at the junction with Bluehouses;
- (iii) to prohibit a "U" turn movement for vehicles from the eastbound carriageway of Southernhay to the westbound carriageway of that road at the junction with Fodderwick;
- (iv) to revoke Article 8 of the District of Basildon (Various Streets, Town Centre, Basildon) (One Way Traffic and Bus Lane) Order 1976, so as to permit vehicles to make a right hand turn movement from Fodderwick into Southernhay.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan relating to it and a statement of the Council's reasons for making it, may be examined at the undermentioned office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. Monday to Friday and at the Local Government Library (E block), County Hall, Chelmsford.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing, marked for the attention of the Committee Services Manager, to the address indicated below by 29th November 1991.
