Hampshire County Council Waiting Restrictions and One-way Traffic Aldworth Crescent/Bolton Crescent, Basingstoke

Notice is hereby given that Hampshire County Council proposes making a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of Order: To impose the following traffic restrictions in Aldworth Crescent and Bolton Crescent:

No Waiting At Any Time in Bolton Crescent

North and east sides, between its northernmost junction with Sandys Road and a point 222.5 metres east and south thereof.

North and west sides, between its southernmost junction with Sandys Road and a point 79.8 metres east and north thereof.

South and west sides, between a point 33 metres east of its northernmost junction with Sandys Road and a point 41.2 metres east and south of that point.

South side, between its southernmost junction with Sandys Road and a point 21 metres east thereof.

Exemptions will be included in the Order for the purpose of loading/unloading and disabled drivers parking.

One-Way Traffic

Aldworth Crescent One-Way traffic in a southerly direction (i.e. anti-clockwise).

Bolton Crescent One-Way traffic in a southerly direction (i.e. clockwise).

The Hertfordshire (Cheddington Lane, Long Marston, Tring Rural) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1991

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Hertfordshire (A411 Elstree Road and Priory View, Bushey) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991
