POWYS COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Powys (Various Roads, Beulah Village) (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that on 31st October 1991 the County Council of Powys made the above-named Order under sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Village of Beulah in the Borough of Brecknock

(1) County Class II No. B4358 Beulah to Newbridge-on-Wye Road, that length which extends from its junction with the A483 Trunk Road near Beulah Bridge in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 430 metres.

(2) County Class III Road No. C23 (leading to Ty Newydd and Llwyn-Howell), that length which extends from its junction with the B4358 for a distance of approximately 180 metres in a generally easterly direction to a point approximately 21 metres east of the eastern boundary of Beulah Congregational Chapel.

(3) County Class III No. C4 Beulah to Abergwesyn Road, that length which extends from its junction with the A483 Trunk Road for a distance of approximately 185 metres in a north-westerly direction to a point approximately 45 metres north-west of the north-western boundary of Caerhof.

(4) County Unclassified Road No. U41, that length which extends from its junction with the A483 Trunk Road for a distance of approximately 154 metres in a generally north-easterly direction to its junction with the C4 Abergwesyn Road and which in part lies adjacent to The Walk. (775)

Borough of Preston (Lowthorpe Place) (Access Only) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Preston Borough Council as agent for the highway authority, the Lancashire County Council under sections 1(1), (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above-mentioned Order.
