ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BRIGHTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Brighton (Churchill Square) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that on 8th November 1991, Brighton Borough Council acting as agents for East Sussex County Council, made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be as follows:

1. *Churchill Square (upper level)*

Prohibition of Driving will be provided with the following exceptions:

- (a) Emergency Service Vehicles.
- (b) The vehicles of statutory undertakings, water and sewerage authorities and telecommunications operators in pursuance of their duties.
- (c) The vehicles of local authorities or their agents in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties.
- (d) Purpose built motorised invalid carriages not exceeding 400 kg (approximately 8 cwt) in unladen weight.
- (e) Vehicles necessary in connection with essential repair work to adjacent premises, provided the vehicles cannot be reasonably used for the same purpose in any other road.
- (f) Vehicles for charitable or public service events with the consent of Brighton Borough Council.

Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on 10th November 1991, and a map showing the area affected, may be examined at the Enquiry Office, Town Hall, Brighton, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 8th November 1991, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
