

(4) To prohibit any vehicles to proceed in that length of Good Street from a point five metres east of Euston Street in an easterly direction for a distance of two metres.

(5) To prohibit any vehicles to wait in the following lengths of road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday for a longer period than 2 hours with return prohibited within 2 hours:

North side of Christ Church Street from its junction with Bow Lane for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.

North side of Christ Church Street from a point 54 metres east of its junction with Langton Street for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.

(6) To prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time except for residents permit holders in the following length of road:

North side of Christ Church Street from a point 12 metres west of its junction with Bow Lane for a distance of 40 metres in a westerly direction.

(7) To prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time in the following lengths of road:

North side of Christ Church Street from a point 52 metres from its junction with Bow Lane for a distance of 15.5 metres in a westerly direction.

South side of Christ Church Street from its junction with Bow Lane to its junction with Spring Bank.

##### *The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport (Heaviley Grove, Heaviley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991*
