(2) The A30 and A39 Trunk Roads (Indian Queens, Fraddon and St. Columb Road Bypasses) Compulsory Purchase Order (No. SW) 199, notice of which was published on 10th October 1991. This is an Order under sections 239 and 240 of the Highways Act 1980 and under section 2 of and Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 which, if made, will authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land described therein for the prupose of:

(i) the construction of the new trunk roads in the Parishes of St. Enoder and St Columb. Major in the District of Restormel in the County of Cornwall in pursuance of the above-mentioned Trunk Road Order; and

(ii) the construction and improvement of highways, the provision of new means of access to premises and the improvement of the A39 Trunk Road in the said Parishes and the use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works, all in pursuance of the above-mentioned Side Roads Order.

(3) The A30 and A39 Trunk Roads (Indian Queens, Fraddon and St. Columb Road Bypasses) (Kelliers Railway Bridge) Compulsory Purchase Order (No. SW) 199, notice of which was published on 10th October 1991. This Order is an Order under sections 239 and 240 of the Highways Act 1980 and under section 2 of and Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 which, if made, will authorise the Secretarty of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land described therein for the purpose of: (i) the construction of the A39 Bypass in the vicinity of The Kelliers in the Parish of St. Enoder in the District of Restormel in the County of Cornwall in pursuance of the above-mentioned Trunk Road Order; and

(ii) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction.

Copies of the above-mentioned draft Side Roads Order and Compulsory Purchase Order and of the plans referred to therein have ben deposited, and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge, at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1 3PY and at the offices of the Director (Transport), South West Region, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DJ; Cornwall County Council, County Hall, Truro TR1 3BE; Restormel Borough Council, 39 Penwinnick Road, St. Austell, PL25 5DR; Fraddon Post Office, Fraddon, Cornwall; and St. Columb Road Post Office, St. Columb Road, Cornwall.

Proceedings on the above-mentioned draft Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of section 257 of the Highways Act 1980.

Objectors are reminded that the substance of their objections or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected by them; that they will be passed to the Inspector holding the inquiries; and that in the event the Inspector may be required to disclose the objections or representations at the inquires and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the authors.
