

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Arrow Road North, Redditch) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given, that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m., and 6.30 p.m., on the eastern side of Arrow Road North in the town and borough of Redditch in the county of Hereford and Worcester from its junction with Holloway Drive to its junction with Brook Street.

Waiting by vehicles of the under-mentioned classes or for the under-mentioned purposes are exempted from the provisions of the Order:

- (a) to enable persons to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto and/or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) vehicles in use by the Post Office;
- (d) for the collection or delivery of furniture or effects with Police consent;
- (e) for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (f) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the side of length of road and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus;
- (g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can conveniently be used).

An exemption in the Order also permit disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's "orange badge" scheme, to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the draft Order and map showing the side of length of road affected and a copy of the County Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:

2. Redditch Borough Council Offices, Town Hall, Alcester Street, Redditch.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lancashire County Council (Simonstone Road, Sabden, Ribble Valley Borough) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that, the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be that no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h., on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Simonstone Road, Sabden, from a point 40 metres south of its junction with Padiham Road (the terminal point of the existing 30 m.p.h. speed limit) for a distance of 120 metres in a south-westerly direction. (722)

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL

The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Amendment) (Bulwer Road) (No. 449) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council as Agents authorised by Leicestershire County Council have made the following Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to come into operation on 18th November 1991.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit vehicles waiting and loading in Bulwer Road, the north side, 8 metres each side of the road closure, including the turning head.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 14th November 1991, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lincolnshire County Council (Various Roads, Horncastle) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in Horncastle:

Conging Street, south side from its junction with North Street to its junction with Water Mill Road.

Banks Road, south side from a point 15 metres east of Linden Road westwards for a distance of 105 metres.

Banks Road/Banks Street, north side from its junction with Linden Road westwards for a distance of 111 metres.

Exceptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity and water and any Telegraphic line.

The Order will come into operation on 20th November 1991 and a copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned may be inspected at County Offices, Lincoln, and the offices of the East Lindsey District Council, Tedder Hall, Manby Park, and Boston Road, Horncastle, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks after 7th November 1991, make application to the High Court for this purpose.

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lincolnshire County Council (Wyberton-A52) and (Wyberton-New Hammond Beck Road) (Derestriction) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make Orders under sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to remove the automatic speed restriction which will be imposed on the following lengths of road owing to the installation of street lighting:

A52 (Swineshead Road), from its junction with Wortleys Lane westwards for approximately 60 metres.

New Hammond Beck Road, from its junction with the unnamed road leading to the Tesco development westwards for a distance of approximately 85 metres.
