LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST

*The Waltham Forest (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 32) Order 1991**Bury Road E.4*

Notice is hereby given, that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 11th November 1991 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to further amend the Waltham Forest (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977, so that vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. throughout the week in Bury Road E.4, between its junction with Rangers Road and Station Road and a point 15 metres north of the entrance to the Chingford Golf Course Caddy House car park, Bury Road.

(Any existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles in Bury Road in the vicinity of its junction with Rangers Road and Station Road will be revoked).

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 14th November 1991, of the above-mentioned Order of 1977 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) and of a map indicating the location and effect of the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at: (a) the Information Desk, Town Hall, Forest Road, Walthamstow E.17; and (b) the Reception Desk, Municipal Offices, The Ridgeway, Chingford E.4.

MACCLESFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Macclesfield (Albert Road (Part) Bollington) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

The Borough of Macclesfield (Shrigley Road, Anson Road, Green Lane and Lyme Road, Higher Poynton) (Prohibition of Waiting Order).

The Borough of Macclesfield (Hope Street West (Part) Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

The Borough of Macclesfield (Knutsford Bus Station, Knutsford) (Off-street Parking Places, Knutsford) Order

The Borough of Macclesfield (Chapel Lane Area, Wilmslow) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

Notice is hereby given that, on 7th November 1991, the Macclesfield Borough Council acting pursuant to arrangements made with Cheshire County Council in accordance with section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, made the above Orders in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders in respect of Albert Road, Bollington, Shrigley Road, Anson Road, Green Lane and Lyme Road, Higher Poynton, and Hope Street West, Macclesfield, is as published in the edition of the *London Gazette* on 28th August 1991.

The Borough of Macclesfield (Knutsford Bus Station, Knutsford) (Off-street Parking Places, Knutsford) Order

The effect of this Order is to permit only public service vehicles operating local services to use the Knutsford Bus Station. The maximum period for which vehicles may wait has been increased from 10 minutes to 20 minutes. The Order includes conditions of use of the Bus Station.

The Borough of Macclesfield (Chapel Lane Area, Wilmslow) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

The effect of this Order has been amended so that it will be operative as follows:

To prohibit waiting at any time on:

Buckingham Road, both sides, from its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 40 metres in a northerly direction.

Clifford Road, west side, from its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction. East side from its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Bourne Street, both sides, from a point 18 metres from its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction.

Lindfield Estate South, both sides, from its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Chapel Lane, south side, from a point 30 metres east of its junction with Nursery Lane for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction.

To prohibit waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive on:

Nursery Lane, east side from a point 30 metres south of its junction with Chapel Lane for a distance of 50 metres in a southerly direction.

The Orders come into operation on 18th November 1991.

Exemptions in respect of Orders 1, 2, 3 and 5 include in respect of building or demolition operations, the loading and unloading of goods; the supply of gas, water, electricity and disabled persons' vehicles.

The documents in respect of Order No. 1 at the Public Library, Palmerston Street, Bollington, the documents in respect of Order No. 2 at the Service Centre, Park Lane, Poynton, and the Public Library, Civic Centre, Park Lane, Poynton, the documents in respect of Order No. 3 at the Public Library, Park Lane, Macclesfield, in respect of Order No. 4 at the Public Library, Brook Street, Knutsford, and in respect of Order No. 5 at the Public Library, South Drive, Wilmslow, all during normal opening hours. The documents in respect of Order No. 4 may be inspected, during normal office hours at the Service Centre, Council Offices, Toft Road, Knutsford, and in respect of Order No. 5 at the Service Centre, Council Offices, South Drive, Wilmslow.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders, they may, within 6 weeks
