*The Penwith District Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1992*

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Penwith propose to make an Order under sections 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act to take effect on 1st April 1992. The Order will relate to the Council's Car Parks set out in the Schedules to this notice.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce and/or continue controls on the use of the parking places named in the Schedules to this notice which show the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place. The Order will incorporate the provisions of the Parking Act 1989 more especially the use of parking devices also offences and proceedings in connection with the parking places provided. The new Order will revoke the Penwith District Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1991 and the Penwith District Council (Off-street Parking Places) Amendment No. 1 Order.

A copy of the proposed Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Council Offices, St. Clare, Penzance.

Anyone wishing to object to the proposed Order should send the grounds of objection in writing to the undersigned by 27th December 1991.
