The Wokingham (Off-street Parking Places) (Variation No. 3) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given, that the Wokingham District Council proposes to make a Variation Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers.

The Order will come into operation as soon as possible and will vary the car parking charges in the undermentioned car parks in the Wokingham District as follows:

1. The charge for parking in the following Wokingham town centre car parks for up to 2 hours will be reduced from the present 80p to 60p:

Rose Street,

Cockpit Path/Luckley Path,

2. A 1 hour parking period will be introduced in the Denmark Street car park, Wokingham at a charge of 40p.
3. The charge for parking in the Council Offices car park Shute End, Wokingham on Saturdays will be deleted, making it a free car park on Saturdays only.

The charges will operate on the days and times specified in the Schedule to the Order or as otherwise referred to above.

The car parks referred to will be regulated by the existing regulations contained in the Wokingham (Off Street Parking Places Order) 1986, as varied.

CHICHESTER DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District Council of Chichester (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Council propose to make an Order under sections 35(1) and 124(1) and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to amend the District Council of Chichester (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1989 in the following manner:

- (a) to vary the charges made for the use of parking places in Chichester in accordance with the particulars described in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) to vary the charges for roving season tickets in Chichester in accordance with the particulars described in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (c) to prohibit the use of roving season tickets in the parking places at New Park Road, Orchard Street and Avenue de Chartres (West), Chichester and
- (d) to delete all reference to the parking places at Cathedral Way, Chichester.
