COAST PROTECTION ACT

SUFFOLK COASTAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Coast Protection Act 1949

Notice is hereby given that the Suffolk Coastal District Council acting in their capacity as Coast Protection Authority, hereby give notice under Sub-Section (1) of section 5 of the above Act that they propose to carry out coast protection works as described herein North of the Dip, Felixstowe.

The work will consist of repairs to the existing stepped concrete sea wall, the replacement of the old steel piled groynes and the replenishment of the beach between the recently completed sea wall northern boundary and the Felixstowe Golf Club house.

The groynes will be reconstructed of imported hardwood, obtained from a renewable source. Beach replenishment material will be sea dredged aggregate discharged on the beach from a dredger.

The reconstructed groynes will extend over a frontage of 260 metres at an estimated cost of £160,000. The beach replenishment is estimated to cost £41,300 and will extend over the same frontage.

Any person may, not later than 24th December 1991, serve a written notice of objection to the above proposal on the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and on the above mentioned Authority. Any such notice must contain a statement on the grounds of objection and must be sent by pre-paid post to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Flood Defence and Land Sales Division, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE and to the Chief Executive of Suffolk Coastal District Council at the address shown below.

STANSTED AIRPORT—LONDON

(Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that Stansted Airport Limited, on Tuesday, 19th November 1991, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, and as having effect by virtue of the Aerodrome Traffic (Stansted) Order 1976 and sections 1, 2 and 65 of the Airports Act 1986 to come into effect on Tuesday, 26th November 1991.

Any person who requires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the provision of the Act, or of any regulations under the Act have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the dates on which the Order was made, make application for the purposes to the High Court.
