(i) Amy Road and Ellice Road; and

(ii) Beatrice Road and Station Road East;

(c) provide that—

(i) the parking places referred to in sub-paragraph (b)(i) above will be in operation at any time;

(ii) provide that the parking places referred to in subparagraph (b)(ii) above will be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(d) specify that any vehicle the overall width of which together with the load (if any) carried thereon does not exceed 2.1 metres may be left in any of the parking places;

- (e) provide that in the parking places referred to in sub-paragraph (b)(i) above vehicles may be left for any period and that in the parking places referred to in sub-paragraph (b)(ii) above the period during which vehicles may be left will be 2 hours;
- (f) provide that the period during which any vehicle may not return to any of the parking places referred to in sub-paragraph (b)(ii) above will be one hour;
- (g) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in any of the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight, to load or unload, to undertake works, etc.;
- (h) revoke all the existing prohibitions on waiting by vehicles imposed by the Order of 1990 referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above in so far as they relate to Amy Road, Beatrice Road and Ellice Road;

(i) prohibit waiting by vehicles:

(i) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the roads and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;

(ii) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive waiting being permitted for a period of one hour with no return permitted for a further period of one hour in the lengths of Station Road East specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(iii) between 8 a.m. and 9.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(iv) between 8 a.m. and 9 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;
