CALDERDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough Council of Calderdale (Traffic Regulation) (No. 4) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Calderdale propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times with the usual exemptions in:

- (1) *Rochdale Road (A58)*, Sowerby Bridge on the south side from a point 15 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Watson Mill Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 68 metres.
- (2) *Watson Mill Lane*, Sowerby Bridge on both sides from the extended southern kerbline of Rochdale Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
