# The Borough of Pendle (Skipton Road/Windsor Street, Coln) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Pendle pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 1(1) and 2, and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time;

- (i) on the east side of Skipton Road, Colne, for 20 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with Windsor Street and for 20 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with Windsor Street;
- (ii) on the west side of Skipton Road, Colne for 20 metres in a northerly direction from its junction with Byron Road and for 20 metres in a southerly direction from its junction with Byron Road:
- (iii) on both sides of Bryon Road, Colne for 20 metres in a westerly direction from its junction with Skipton Road;
- (iv) on both sides of Bryan Road, Colne for 20 metres in a westerly direction from its junction with Skipton Road.

The subject to no objections being lodged in response to the notices, the Order be made.

The Order will contain exemptions for emergency vehicles, vehicles used in connection with the construction and demolition works, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water or of any telegraphic lines as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, and local authority vehicles being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order, and of the relevant map showing the proposals and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the Town Hall, Nelson and the Town Hall, Colne, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m., on Monday to Thursday, and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., on Friday.

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council, on 22nd November 1991, made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Notice of the Council's intention to make this Order was first given in Issue No. 52551 of the London Gazette, dated 6th June 1991, Ref. No. 504. page 8739, and the effects of the final Order are as described below.

The Order comes into operation on 2nd December 1991.

#### **Prohibition** of Waiting

(1) Haslemere Road

- (a) Both sides, from a point 4 metres north of the junction with Grayshott Road to a point 4 metres south of that junction. (In front of Nos. 10, 12, 9 and 11).
- (b) Both sides, from a point 4 metres north of the junction with Bramshott Road to a point 4 metres south of that junction. (In from of Nos. 30, 32, 29 and 31).
- (c) Both sides, from a point 4 metres north of the junction with Liss Road to a point 4 metres south of that junction. (In front of Nos. 48, 50, 47 and 49).
- (d) Both sides, from a point 4 metres north of the junction with Empshott Road to a point 4 metres south of that junction. (In front of Nos. 68, 70, 55 and 67).
- (e) Both sides, from a point 4 metres north of the junction with Heyshott Road to a point 4 metres south of that junction. (In front of Nos. 88, 90, 81 and 83).
- (2) Grayshott Road; Both sides, from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to a point 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flanks of Nos. 9, 10, 11 and 12).

(3) Bramshot Road; Both sides, from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to a point 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flanks of Nos. 29, 30, 31 and 32).

# (4) Liss Road

(a) The north side from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Hastemere Road to apoint 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flank of Nos. 47 and 48).

(b) the south side from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to apoint 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flank of Nos. 49 and 50).

(5) Empshott Road

(a) The north side from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to a point 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flank of Nos. 55 and 68).

(b) the south side from a point 1 metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to a point 1 metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flank of Nos. 67 and 70).

(6) Heyshott Road; Both sides, from a point I metre west of the junction with Haslemere Road to a point I metre east of that junction. (Alongside part of the flank of Nos. 81, 83, 88 and 90).
