The West Somerset (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1992

The West Somerset (Various Streets — Minehead and Porlock) (On-Street Parking Places) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of West Somerset pursuant to their powers, under sections 35(1) and (3), 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) hereby give notice that they propose to make the above-named Orders to control:

(a) The use of the Off-Street Parking Places named in Schedule 1 to this Notice which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place; and

(b) The use of the On-Street Parking Places named in Schedule 2 to this Notice which sets out the proposed scale of charges and certain other details relating to the operation of the parking places.

It is proposed to bring these proposals into effect from 1st April 1992. The main changes relate to the fees to be charged for the longer stays of up to ten hours, weekly, three months and seven months. There are also some proposed amendments to the three to four hours stopping period to standardise this section to four hours stays in all car parks. In addition, it is proposed to remove the current twelve hours maximum stay limit in the majority of 'pay and display' car parks. It is not proposed to make any increase to the excess car parking charge of £30 (reduced to £12.50 if payment is made within seven days).

The Orders will specify the conditions under which the Parking Places may be used and full details are contained in the draft Orders which, together with plans showing the location of the parking places involved and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Orders may be inspected at the Council Offices, 37 Blenheim Road, Minehead and the Council Offices, 20 Fore Street, Williton, during normal office hours.
