TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 249

Town and Country Planning General Regulations 1976

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of West Sussex) (No. 2) Order 1991".

This Order comes into operation on 2nd January 1992 and extinguishes any rights which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on the part of the Steyne, Bognor Regis, described in Schedule 1 to the Order.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, by applying to the Director, South East Network Management Division, Department of Transport, Senet House, Station Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1HJ (quoting ref. No. MSE 5078/0/0/24/4/2). It may also be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Bognor Regis Town Hall, Clarence Road, Bognor Regis.

If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirements of that Act, or of any regulations made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, within 6 weeks from 2nd January 1992 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained in it.

Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application any person who, on 12th December 1991, had an interest in land having a lawful access to the highway to which the Order relates may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the Arun District Council in respect of any depreciation in value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. Any claim must be served on the Council at the above address within a period of 6 months from 12th December 1991, unless the period is extended in any particular case by the Secretary of State.

The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Essex) (No.) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of Mr. K. Hiscock, he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of part of the highway verge at West Park Avenue, Billericay, Essex (adjacent to 22 West Park Crescent) to enable development consisting of a garage and fence to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Munday and Cramer for Mr P. Barber by Basildon District Council under Part III of the said Act.
