#### NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

*The New Town of Milton Keynes Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way Over Part of Footpath 11, Part of Footpath 12 and Part of Footpath 13—Shenley Brook End.*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following routes, shown coloured red on the map referred to herein, and located in the Parish of Shenley Brook End:

That part of footpath no. 11 which is located between points "G" and "H" on the map, and which runs from its junction with footpath no. 12 in a westerly direction for approximately 70 metres to its junction with the leisure route lying to the east of Loughton Brook

That part of footpath no. 12 which runs—

(i) from point "A" on the map (located 130 metres south-west of Tattenhoe Hall Farm) in a generally north-westerly direction for approximately 330 metres to point "B"; then

(ii) from point "B" in a north-easterly direction for approximately 320 metres to point "C" (located where the footpath meets footpath 13); and continuing

(iii) from point "C" in an easterly direction for approximately 420 metres to point "D" (being the footpath's junction with the northern carriageway of City Road H8 Standing Way)

That part of footpath no. 13 which runs—

(i) from point "E" on the map (located approximately 40 metres south-east of Loughton Brook) in a south-easterly

direction for approximately 50 metres to point "C" (where the footpath meets footpath 12); then

(ii) from point "C" in an easterly direction for approximately 520 metres to point "F" (being the footpath's junction with the northern carriageway of City Road H8 Standing Way in the vicinity of the roundabout junction of City Roads H8 and V2).

The map (Development Corporation ref. DDD/HU 12(A)) showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Milton Keynes Development Corporation, Saxon Court, 502 Avebury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes MK9 3HS, during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Ref. NT/5444/3/39), Room P2/153, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, not later than 14th February 1992.
