

- (a) to prohibit waiting at any time in the sides of lengths of roads in the Town and District of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester specified in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (b) to prohibit waiting at any time between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday inclusive in the side of lengths of road in the Town and District of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and/or unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office Vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with Police consent;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of any telecommunications apparatus;
- (f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services;
- (g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can be conveniently used).

Exemptions in the Order also permit disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge and parking disc issued under the Local Authority's "orange badge" Scheme to wait on the sides of lengths of road specified in the First and Second Schedules to this notice for a maximum of 2 hours (return prohibited within one hour).

The Order will come into operation on 20th January 1992.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order were made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Sides of lengths of roads in the Town and District of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester

Worcester Road, west side from its junction with Sanders Road for a distance of 15 metres (49 feet) in a north-easterly and south-westerly direction.

Sanders Road, both sides from its junction with Worcester Road for a distance of 15 metres (49 feet) in a north-westerly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Side of lengths of roads in the Town and District of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester

Sanders Road, north side:

- (a) From a point 15 metres (49 feet) north-west of its junction with Worcester Road to its junction with Gas Square.
- (b) From its junction with Gas Square for a distance of 88 metres (288 feet) in a north-westerly direction.

HEREFORD & WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Beaufort Street, South Street and West Avenue, Redditch) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that on 9th January 1992, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding or waiting in the entire lengths of Beaufort Street, South Street and West Avenue and that length of West Street from its junction with South Street for a distance of 9 metres (30 feet) in the Town and Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester.

Exemptions are contained in the Order for vehicles of the following classes or for the following purposes if the vehicle:

- (a) is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (b) is being used in any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road, and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity and telecommunications apparatus;
- (c) is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) is a mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
- (e) is being used to gain access to any land or premises where there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
- (f) is being used for delivery or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.

The Order will come into operation on 21st January 1992.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order were made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The County of Hereford and Worcester (A491, Bromsgrove—Stourbridge Road) Experimental Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns and U-Turns) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that on 9th January 1992, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prevent any vehicle from proceeding in the Parish of Belbroughton in the District of Bromsgrove in the County of Hereford and Worcester in:

1. Heath End Lane and making a right-hand turn into A491, Bromsgrove—Stourbridge Road.
2. Western Road and making a right-hand turn into A491, Bromsgrove—Stourbridge Road.
3. Eastern carriageway of A491 Bromsgrove—Stourbridge Road and making a U-turn into western carriageway or making a right-hand turn into Mearse Lane.

Full details of this proposal are contained in the Order which together with a map showing the roads affected and statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be examined from Monday to Friday during normal working hours at:

2. County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester.

The Orders are expected to be in operation for an initial experimental period not exceeding 18 months, and will come into force on 20th January 1992.

The Council will in due course be considering whether the provisions of the experimental Orders should be continued in force indefinitely.

Any person wishing to object to the making of Orders continuing the experimental Orders in force indefinitely must do so in writing to the undersigned, stating the grounds of objection, within a period of 6 months from 16th January 1992.
