The Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. ) Traffic Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to further amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1991 so that the restrictions in that Order now also apply to parts of Chislehurst Road and Frognal Avenue, Sidcup.

A copy of the proposed Order, of the above-mentioned Order of 1991 (and of the Orders that have previously amended that Order), the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, and of the maps which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from which this notice is published, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in:

- (a) Chief Engineer's Department, Sidcup Place, Sidcup, Kent DA14 6BT, and
- (b) The Information Centre, Bexley Civic Centre, Broadway, Bexleyheath, Kent DA5 7LB.

Persons objecting to the proposed Order should be aware that in view of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, this Council would be legally obliged to make any comments received to this notice open to public inspection.

## LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT

The Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. )
Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

- 2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:
  - (i) the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on waiting by vehicles would be changed so that such prohibition would apply at any time in the length of Albion Way specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
  - (ii) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
  - (iii) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m., and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of North End Road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
  - (iv) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place:
    - (a) would be changed so that prohibition would apply between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the length of Albion Way referred to in sub-paragraph (i) above;
    - (b) would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (ii) above;
    - (c) would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of North End Road referred to in sub-paragraph (iii) above;
  - (v) in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) and (iii) above:

- (a) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (b) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, would be prohibited.
- 3. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2(ii) and (iii) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.

#### SCHEDULE 1

Albion Way, between the south-eastern kerb-line of North End Road and a point 18.29 metres south-east of that kerb-line.

#### SCHEDULE 2

Albion Way, between the northern kerb-line of Fulton Road and a point 18·29 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of North End Road.

### Fulton Road:

- (a) the north and north-east sides
  - (i) between a point 18·29 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Rutherford Way and a point 6 metres south-east of a point opposite the north-westernmost wall of No. 1 Watkin Road;
  - (ii) between a point 2 metres south-east of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 2 and 3 Watkin Road and a point 21 metres south-east of that wall;
- (iii) between a point 10 metres south-east of a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 4c Watkin Road and a point 18·29 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Fifth Way;
   (b) the south and south-west sides
  - (i) between a point 18.29 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Rutherford Way and a point 25 metres east of that kerb-line;
  - (ii) between a point 8 metres west of a point opposite the eastern wall of Apex House, Fulton Road, a point 30 metres east of that wall;
  - (iii) between a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 11 Watkin Road and a point 18·29 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Fifth Way.
- Rutherford Way, the west side between a point 18·29 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Fulton Road and a point 155·29 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Engineers Way.
- Watkin Road, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Fulton Road and a point 18.29 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

#### SCHEDULE 3

North End Road, the south and south-west sides between a point opposite the eastern wall of No. 25 to 48 Empire Court, North End Road and its south-easternmost extremity.
