

SCHEDULE 2

Introduction of No Waiting at any time, no loading/unloading 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday

Bury New Road, both sides, from the boundary with the City of Manchester to the junction with Wellington Street West.

Great Cheetham Street East, south side, from Bury New Road to the junction with Back Roman Road.

Great Cheetham Street East, south side, from the junction with St. James Road to the junction with Tully Street South.

Great Cheetham Street East, north side, from Bury New Road for a distance of 45 metres.

Great Cheetham Street East, north side, from the easterly kerb-line of Bevendon Square to a point opposite the centre line of St. James Road.

St. James Road, both sides, from the south-easterly kerb-line of Great Cheetham Street East to the junction with Marlborough Road.

Great Cheetham Street West, south side, from a point 50 metres east of the easterly kerb-line of Great Clowes Street to the westerly kerb-line of Cornet Street.

Great Cheetham Street West, south side, from a point 20 metres east of the junction with Hilton Street to the westerly kerb-line of Bury New Road.

Marlborough Road, west side, from its junction with St. James Road to the rear of No. 2 St. James Road, a distance of 30 metres.

Marlborough Road, east and north sides, from a point 38 metres north of the junction with St. James Road to a point opposite the north-westerly kerb-line of Craddock Drive.

Marlborough Road, south-west side, from the easterly kerb-line of Northgraves Drive to the westerly kerb-line of Craddock Drive.

Great Cheetham Street West, south side, from the easterly kerb-line of Cornet Street to a point 15 metres west of the westerly kerb-line of Penlands Avenue.

Great Cheetham Street West, south side, from a point 15 metres east of the easterly kerb-line of Pentlands Avenue to the westerly kerb-line of Hilton Street.

Great Cheetham Street East, north side, from a point 45 metres east of the easterly kerb-line of Bury New Road to the westerly kerb-line of Bevendon Square.

(Newearth Road, Hilton Lane, Bridgewater Road and Park Road, Walkden Worsley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1989 Amendment Order 1992

Newearth Road, south-east side, from the southerly kerb-line of Park Road, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 34 metres.
