Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 88 and Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Wessex Water Services Ltd. to enhance the capacity of Crowcombe Sewage Treatment Works by increasing the volume treated and providing for settlement of storm sewage. The effluents are discharged to a tributary of the Doniford Stream at National Grid Reference ST 1380 3655.

Wessex Water Services Ltd. are undertaking improvements to the treatment works to cater for the increase in sewage flows to the treatment works that has taken place and projected future growth. Application has been made to discharge treated sewage effluent up to a dry weather flow of 102 cubic metres per day. When sewage flow to the works exceeds 3.1 litres per second (268 cubic metres per day) due to rainfall, screened sewage will be directed to a storm tank for settlement prior to overflow to the watercourse.
