

SOUTH TYNESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

South Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council (Broughton Road, South Shields) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given, that on 6th February 1992 the Council of the Borough of South Tyneside made an Order under sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of this Order, which comes into operation on 17th February 1992, is to permit only a disabled person's vehicle which displays a disabled person's badge to park in that length of road, on such days and during such hours as specified in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the parking places are available at the offices of the Director of Legal and Administrative Services, Town Hall and Civic Offices, South Shields, and may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, you may within 6 weeks from 6th February 1992 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The plan became operative on 17th February 1992, but if any person aggrieved by the plan desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (formerly Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971), or that any requirement of the said Part II or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the plan, he/she may, within 6 weeks from 17th February 1992 make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (formerly section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971).

ROTHER DISTRICT COUNCIL

PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990

Bexhill Town Centre Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that the Rother District Council as local planning authority, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 has on 3rd February 1992 designated the area of land described in the Schedule of this Notice as a Conservation Area.

Within the area described in the Schedule the consequences of designation are that:

- (1) the demolition of certain buildings is brought under control;
- (2) any person proposing to do work on trees in the area is required to give six week's prior notification to the local planning authority of his intention, unless the trees are already protected by a Tree Preservation Order, in which case an application for consent will be required;
- (3) the authority come under a duty to formulate and publish proposals for the preservation and enhancement of the area;
- (4) planning applications for development which would, in the opinion of the local planning authority, affect the character or appearance of the conservation area must be given publicity and representations received in consequence taken into account in determining the application.

The area which is specified in the Schedule to this Notice is defined on a map which is available for inspection on Mondays to Fridays from 8.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. at the Town Hall, Bexhill-on-Sea, or may be purchased, price 50p including postage, from the same address.

SCHEDULE

All that land and buildings enclosed by a boundary which is briefly described as follows:

Commencing at the junction of Station Road and Sea Road the boundary runs to the rear of the properties fronting the east side of Sea Road, southwards to Marina, where turning west it passes along Channel View, south of The Colonnade as far as the junction between West Parade and Park Road. The line here turns north along Park Road until it meets the boundary of the Hastings to Brighton railway line where it turns eastwards following the line's southern boundary to Devonshire Square. At this point the boundary crosses the railway line to run along its northern edge, i.e. along the south side of Station Road to end at the junction with Sea Road.
