TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of the whole of Fairfax Street subway, part widths of the footway of Fairfax Street, a part width of Fairfax Street, a part width of the footway of Hales Street and a part width of the footway running along the northern boundary of the Pool Meadow Bus Station, Pool Meadow, Coventry to enable development consisting of a new bus station and leisure complex with retail kiosks, pub/bistro, public convenience, hotel extension, public car park, bowling alley, skating rink, cinema, discotheque and ancillary facilities to be carried out in accordance with outline planning permission granted to The Rank Organisation Plc by City of Coventry under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new footway maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the City of Coventry and also the improvements of existing highway.

Stopping-up of a Highway at Blackpool
